Dear Patient,

Enclosed is information about how to prepare for your upper endoscopy (EGD). <u>Please read these instructions as soon as possible as some medications must be stopped a week before your procedure.</u>

You will be sedated for this procedure, and unable to drive until the next day. You must bring a driver who can stay with you the entire time you are here and drive you home. Failure to do so will result in your procedure being rescheduled. Free wireless internet is available in our waiting room for guests to use.

We strive to stay on schedule. Our goal is to begin your procedure within one hour after the arrival time noted above. Your expected time at the endoscopy center will be 3 hours or less. Please arrive on time with completed paperwork. You will be delayed or moved to the end of the schedule if you fail to do so.

As a courtesy to other patients and to our staff, we require at least two business days notice for cancellation or rescheduling of procedures. Please see the financial policy included in this packet for more details. Call our office at (629) 255-2154 with any questions.

Expect to receive a call from a nurse one week prior to your procedure. This is to confirm your appointment and answer any questions you may have. You may also receive a survey phone call after your procedure. Please take the time to provide feedback so that we can continue to improve. We are honored by the trust you are placing in us and appreciate the opportunity to serve you.

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Preparing for your Upper Endoscopy (EGD)

- A. If you take **blood thinners** and have not spoken with a nurse at our office regarding holding this medication, please contact us as soon as possible. If you are unsure, please call and speak with a nurse in our office. A few examples of blood thinners are listed below:
 - Coumadin (Warfarin), Plavix (Clopidogrel), Xarelto, Eliquis, Effient
- B. If you have an **implanted pacemaker** or **defibrillator** and have not spoken with a nurse regarding this, please notify our office.
- C. **If you are diabetic who relies on insulin**, please call the physician who manages your diabetes for advice on how to regulate your medication during your prep and on the day of your procedure.
- D. **If you take any GLP-1 medications for weight loss/diabetes**, please stop these for **two weeks** prior to your procedure. See the table below for list of GLP-1 medications.
- E. Please see the table below for which medications to stop taking before your procedure:

F. Continue using any prescribed inhalers and bring them with you to your appointment.

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THE DAY BEFORE YOUR EGD

- Eat and drink normal during the day
- Eat a **light** meal for dinner (avoid having a large, fatty meal)
- Nothing to eat or drink after midnight

THE DAY OF YOUR EGD

- **Do not eat or drink anything after midnight.** Do not use chewing tobacco or smokeless tobacco of any kind on the morning of your procedure. Failure to comply with these directions will result in delay or cancellation of your procedure.
- Take your necessary medications at least two hours prior to the procedure with only enough water to swallow the pills.
- Wear comfortable clothes that are easy to put back on and wear socks to keep your feet warm. Do not wear jewelry, apply lotion to the chest area, or wear contact lenses unless you can sleep in them.

Please bring the following to your appointment:

- An updated list of medications and dosages (or bring your medications with you)
- A responsible adult who must stay in the waiting room and drive you home
 - You must not operate a motor vehicle until the following day.
 - We cannot start preparing you for your procedure unless your driver is present.
 - This person will help you remember what the doctor tells you about the results.
- Two forms of ID *or* one photo ID (driver's license, passport, etc.)
- Your insurance cards
- Fully completed forms that are included in this packet

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

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PATIENT RIGHTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

You and your family should be as comfortable as possible and know that YOU are our number one concern during your visit to Digestive Disease Endoscopy Center. The following statement of your rights and responsibilities is presented as the policy of this facility, but does not presume to be a complete representation of all-mutual rights and responsibilities.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT:

- To impartial access to the medical resources of the center without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, handicapping or disabling condition, spiritual or ethical beliefs or source of payment.

- To receive considerate, respectful care, which recognizes your personal dignity at all times and under all circumstances.
- To participate in decisions involving your care. Except in an emergency situation, you shall not be subjected to any
 procedure without your voluntary, competent and understanding consent or the consent of your legally authorized
 representative.
- To refuse treatment to the extent permitted by law and to be informed of the consequences of that refusal.
- To information about Advance Directives, such as Living Will or Durable Power of Attorney for Health Care, that would allow you to make your own health care decisions for the future and to have your chosen representative exercise these rights for you if you are not able to do so.
- To instructional and educational information about your medical treatment in a language and terms that you understand.
- To the confidential treatment of and personal access to your medical record.
- To know who is responsible for providing your direct care and to receive information concerning your continuing health care needs and alternative for meeting those needs.

YOU HAVE THE RESPONSIBILITY:

- To give your doctor and the staff complete and accurate information about your condition and care. To follow instructions of your doctor and the staff of the center and to keep appointments relative to your care.
- To make it known whether you clearly understand planned actions and treatment and what is expected of you.
- To report unexpected changes in your condition to your physician or staff. To accept the financial obligations
 associated with your care.
- To advise your doctor or any office staff member of any dissatisfaction your may have regarding your care.
- To be considerate of other patients and of staff members who are caring for you.

<u>Insurance and Fees</u>: Please provide your current insurance information when you schedule your appointment and bring proof of your insurance with each visit. If you have any questions about our charges or your bill, please call our billing office at 629-255-3880.

Collection of Co-Payments and Payments of your Bill: Payment of all known deductibles, co-payments, coinsurance, outstanding balances and non-covered services will be required at the time service is rendered. Patients who do not have proof of insurance will be responsible for full payment at the time of service. For out-of-network patients, we require full payment at the time of the service but we will file your insurance claims for reimbursement on your behalf as a courtesy.

Billing Notification: You will receive three billing statements for services rendered to you during your procedure.

- -Professional services provided by your physician will be billed by Heritage Medical Associates. If you have questions regarding the physician's professional fee please call 629-255-3880.
- -You will receive a separate statement from Digestive Disease Endoscopy Center for services provided by the center's staff and for medical equipment and supplies utilized during your procedure. If you have questions, please call 629-255-3514.
- -Anesthesia for your procedure at Digestive Disease Endoscopy Center will be provided by DDEC Anesthesia, LLC. Anesthesia services are billed separately to your insurance. You will receive a billing statement for your balance due once we have received correct payment from your insurance. Please call 1 866 556-8824 for any questions relating to your anesthesia billing statement.
- -In the event that biopsies are taken and/or polyps are removed you will also receive a separate billing statement from the pathology provider.

Payment Options for Payments: We accept Cash, Check, Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express. There is a \$25.00 returned check fee for all checks returned for insufficient funds. Post-dated checks will not be accepted.

Past Due Balances: We require that past due balances be paid, in full, prior to a subsequent office visit.

Outstanding balances may result in dismissal from the practice: If you are unable to make payment, please contact our Business Office at 629-255-3474. In the event an account is placed with a collection agency, you will be responsible for the 30% collection fee, court costs and legal fees.

Missed Appointment Policy: Should you need to cancel or reschedule your appointment we ask that you advise us a minimum of 3 business days in advance of your scheduled appointment. Failure to notify the office could result in a charge of \$250.00 to your account. Multiple missed appointments may result in dismissal from the practice. If you arrive late you may be asked to reschedule your appointment.
